

## November Expectations



### ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS (Reading, Writing, Listening and Speaking)

#### Reading

1. Read their first name
2. Knows 11 sight words: I, can, we, the, am, to, have, like, a see, go
3. Recognizes 19-25 uppercase and lowercase letters
4. Knows 8 or more letter sounds
5. Able to recognize words that rhyme (for example: cat rhymes with hat)
6. Can count 2-3 syllables in words (for example: apple is "ap" - "ple")
7. Knows what a noun and a verb is.
8. Can name the characters of a story and how they are alike or different.
9. Can name the setting (the place) of the story.
10. Knows that an author writes the words and an illustrator draws the pictures.
11. Identifies the front cover, the back cover and title page of a book.
12. Understands that pictures and words are related in a book.
13. Answers questions about important details in a story.
14. Can tell the major events of a story.

#### Writing

1. Writes first name neatly and independently beginning with a capital letter.
2. Can copy the entire alphabet neatly
3. Can write the letter that matches the sound they hear.
4. Can write 1 sentence independently (i.e. "We like a \_\_\_\_.") using spacing correctly.
5. Uses a capital letter at the beginning of the sentence and a period at the end.
6. Is able to draw and talk about their picture.
7. The picture must reflect what is being taught.

#### Listening and Speaking

1. Listens to others and takes turns to speak.
2. Actively participates in conversations in small and large groups
3. Can ask and answer questions in one to two words
4. Can identify feelings based on pictures

## Math

1. Can count read and write numbers to 10
2. Can count 10 or more objects
3. recognizes all basic shapes: circle, square, rectangle, triangle, star, heart, diamond, oval
4. can sort objects in 2 different ways and tell why they chose to sort that way

## Social Science

1. knows and understands rules and consequences
2. Can use a calendar to put events in order
3. Can name 1-2 school workers
4. Can demonstrate the terms: near/far, left/right, behind/in front, etc.
5. Understands what a holiday is and can name one holiday

## Health and PE

1. Knows what 911 is
2. Knows parents names
3. Knows phone number
4. Can tell what it means to be safe
5. Understands germs and how we prevent the spread of germs
6. can name body parts
7. understands what emotions are
8. Knows the difference between appropriate and inappropriate touching
9. Understands the importance of good nutrition
10. Can hold a pencil and scissors correctly
11. Uses correct amount of glue
12. Understands the importance of physical activity

## Science

1. Knows colors: red, orange, yellow, green, blue, purple, pink, brown, white, black
2. Understands the difference between sight, sound, touch, taste and smell
3. Can tell the position of objects (above/below, etc.)
4. Can sort objects by one common factor (shape, size, texture, weight, etc)
